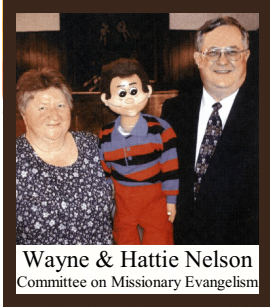

Emergency Road Help



It all started during two weeks of camp in July when we were sharing God's Word at Pennwood Bible Camp located in Ulysses, Pennsylvania. Our 1995 Ford Escort which we tow behind our motor

home broke a valve seat and damaged the engine beyond repair.

After a few sleepless nights, some emotional roller coaster rides and much prayer, the Lord started leading us to consider various avenues to resolve the problem. Another missionary had given me information on GSBM. The Holy Spirit took total control of the situation. Brother Easter called Pastor Roger Hain of Grace Bible Independent Baptist Church of Shinglehouse, Pennsylvania. Grace picked up the car, purchased another engine from a salvage yard and had it installed. Shockingly, the first engine had a rod knock and the second engine had a blown head gasket.

After much counsel, the need for another engine was very obvious. Through a Christian dealer, Christ provided a 2003 Saturn Vue at a wholesale price. Without our knowledge and the dealer's understanding, this Saturn Vue could not be towed, but God gave the full value of the 2003 Vue as a trade in toward a used 2009 Saturn Vue.

Even though this has been a very emotional,

tearful, and challenging time, we are rejoice for the \$1,600 given by GSBM, Grace and Victory Baptist Church.

Thanks for being so faithful in solving the problems and providing this wonderful means of transportation to help reach the lost and encourage the saints.
